A. Figures

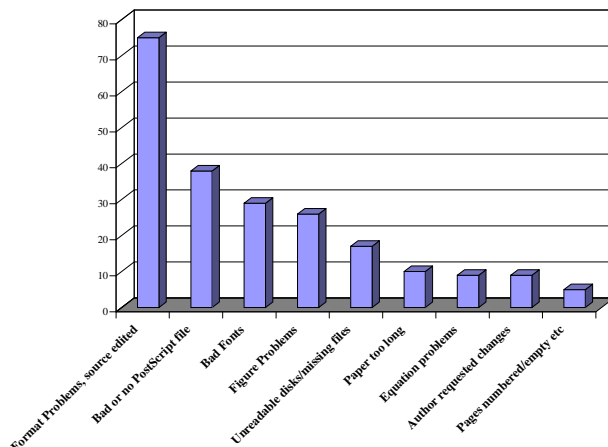


FIG. 1: Example of a One-column Figure. The figure file is taken from the DPF2009 conference proceedings template[1].
